

SUPPLY LIST

- ~small gourd that sits flat
- ~white charcoal pencil
- ~measuring tape, soft seamstress tape is the best
- ~1/32" bit or size that your needle will fit through the drilled hole, and electric drill-if you don't have a drill you can use an awl
- ~artificial sinew-color of your choice it is available at many craft stores

- ~tapestry needle-this is a large eyed needle with a dull point, available at most craft stores
- ~black paint, or some finish for the inside of the gourd
- ~finish for the outside of the gourd-your choice, a nice finish is brown wax shoe polish buffed to a nice sheen
- ~scissors
- ~small terry towel
- ~soft smooth cloth
- ~small piece of masking tape
- ~gauge-large drinking straw cut into 1/5" length will work. You can purchase a copper gauge at www.primpines.com
