

## Colorful Coils Supply List

- ~a cleaned gourd that sits flat, wide enough that you can cut at least a 5" opening
- ~paste floor wax or paste shoe polish
- ~white charcoal pencil-available at craft and art stores, purchase one you won't be sorry.
- ~mini jig saw
- ~cleaning tools
- ~interior finish either black paint or you can decoupage with paper I prefer using black paint in the interior, any acrylic will work but Apple Barrel black gloss gives a nice interior finish.
- ~drill and 1/32" bit or awl (I purchased an awl from [www.caningshop.com](http://www.caningshop.com) that works great) A drill is best though
- ~measuring tape-a seamstress tape works well as it bends
- ~natural pine needles and two other colors - you can purchase pine needles from [www.turtlefeathers.com](http://www.turtlefeathers.com) or [www.caningshop.com](http://www.caningshop.com) or you may have your favorite supplier. You can dye your own using Rit dye contact me for the process
- ~artificial sinew in black, natural or your choice-available from [www.turtlefeathers.com](http://www.turtlefeathers.com) or [www.caningshop.com](http://www.caningshop.com) or Michaels'
- ~tapestry needle- this needle has a large eye and a blunt end-available at most craft and sewing stores
- ~small scissors
- ~several small beads, with a hole large enough for the sinew to pass through
- ~spray varnish I prefer Krylon gloss
