

# Supply List for Batik

- ~a gourd that sits flat, one that you can cut a 5—6” opening in, large enough to fit your hand in
- ~saw for cutting gourd-I prefer an electric jig saw
- ~white charcoal pencil, or pencil
- ~eraser
- ~measuring tape-preferably a seamstress tape that is soft and bendable
- ~Frisket Masking Fluid- you can purchase this in any craft/art store  
There are different brands, whichever you want to purchase will work
- ~leather dyes-various colors of leather dyes, at least 3—you can purchase them at some craft stores and online at <http://www.turtelfeathers.com>  
Or <http://www.caningshop.com>
- ~small mop type paint brush-with soft bristles-throw away is good
- ~one bundle of long leaf pine needles
- ~artificial sinew, color of your choice-available at some craft stores or online from <http://www.turtelfeathers.com> or <http://www.caningshop.com>
- ~black acrylic paint for the interior
- ~tapestry needle-these are blunt and have a large eye
- ~electric drill or awl
- ~1/32 or 1/16” bit for the drill, or size that your needle will fit through the drilled hole
