

Tenerife ornament –pine needle coiling

SUPPLY LIST

- round gourd piece- you can cut this from a gourd scrap
- pine needles—I used green for this project, you may use color of your choice or natural. www.turtlefeathers.com has dyed pine needles.
- red acrylic paint
- black acrylic paint
- artificial sinew, red or color of your choice –colored sinew is available at craft stores, www.turtlefeathers.com
- white waxed linen or crochet cotton—waxed linen can be purchased at www.royalwoodltd.com, crochet cotton is available at many craft stores.
- electric drill - if you don't have a drill an awl will work to make the holes around the piece, a drill is much easier
- 1/32" bit for drill
- jigsaw
- 1/2" flat brush
- tapestry needle—available at sewing and craft stores
- small bead, or seed bead
- Krylon glossy or finish of your choice

If you have trouble finding your supplies, I have a **kit available** . The kit cost is \$15 plus \$4 shipping and takes about 2 weeks for delivery.
